Job Description

The successful candidate belongs to the Belle II group and carries out the on-site RAW data management as well as the data distribution from KEK to remote sites. The person will also make significant contributions to necessary R&D for those purposes.

Qualification

An applicant must have good skills in computing and software, and must demonstrate and prove that one is capable to carry out the described jobs.

Method of Selection

After reviewing the submitted application documents (see below), applicant may be asked for an interview.

Salary

Base annual salary: 5,000,000yen
